

# PROPOSITION 65

# WARNING

**AMMUNITION AND OTHER PRODUCTS AT THIS FACILITY CONTAIN LEAD, COPPER, ZINC, OTHER HEAVY METALS, OR OTHER CHEMICALS KNOWN TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO CAUSE CANCER, BIRTH DEFECTS, OR OTHER REPRODUCTIVE HARM.**

**REDUCING EXPOSURE:** Contamination in the air, in dust, and on skin is often invisible. Exposure can be reduced but not entirely eliminated. Do not place your hands in your mouth after handling. Keep food and drink away from exposure. Wash hands immediately after contact or handling. Do not inhale dust. Do not place the products in your mouth. Keep pregnant women and children away.

The foregoing warning is provided pursuant to Proposition 65. This law requires the Governor of California to publish a list of chemicals “known to the State to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity.” This list is compiled in accordance with a procedure established by the Proposition, and can be obtained from the California Environmental Protection Agency. Proposition 65 requires that clear and reasonable warning be given to persons exposed to the listed chemicals in certain situations.
